Tubes and grips along with all piercing implements are sterilized in our autoclave which is medical grade sterilization equipment!

All ink used by the artist during the tattoo process is put into individual ink cups and disposed of after each client!

At the request of each client Blacky's Tattoo Studio can use a pain reducing spray to make the time you spend with us more pleasurable!

## Information and warning of risk

The risks: The practice of tattooing may lead to the introduction of micro-organisms in to the tattoo sight.

The risk of micro-organism can be transmitted by unclean or non sterilized equipment or self contamination from unclean personal practices.

It is important to notify the tattoo artist of all such conditions: hepatitis (B or C) and / or bacterial infections such as (staphylococci, streptococci, pyocyanus).

It is recommended not to get a tattoo when these conditions apply to you: cancer, diabetes of the blood, diabetes, and certain genetic diseases: the use of prolonged steroids and anti-inflammatory drugs which may lead to lower defense capacity of the organs.

Other risks: allergic reactions to metals, inks and products used for the tattoo after care.

Our studio owns autoclave equipment valid for sterilizing medical devices.

**Normal healing reactions include: redness, swelling, irritation, excess ink and blood**

Washing hands: Lather the soap and rub hands on the top, between the fingers, thumbs, fingertips and nails about 30 seconds rinse.

With the hand only, wipe with cool water and mild soap or antibacterial soap, remove all traces of ointment, rinse thoroughly.

With a damp paper towel, wipe gently to remove excess ink and blood.

Apply the ointment; Apply a very thin layer of ointment: bacitin, bacitracin. Covering the whole tattoo area.

**Use of Polysporin and Neosporin is not recommended!**

## Care for the next three days

*You must have ointment on the tattoo sight at all times (a thin layer) and it must be covered at all times aside from application of ointment **DO NOT LET DRY***

*Ointment must be applied 3 -4 times daily for three (3) days, each time wiping off excess blood and/or ink with a damp paper towel, using fresh cellophane each and every time ointment is applied!*

*On the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) day you can remove the cellophane wrap wipe again with damp paper towel.*

*When it starts to dry...*

*Apply a layer of moisturizer (no perfume) example of cream to use (Lubriderm)... Until the scab (dry skin) has completely fallen.*

*Things to avoid:*

*Scratching*

*Picking*

*Getting wet*
